

Development Group Guidance

Purpose

A Development Group is formed to examine a Modification Proposal where the Modification Panel considers that either:

- it requires more detail or explanation; or
- there may be a better method to facilitate the Relevant Objectives.

Scope and Deliverables

The Development Group will only consider the Modification Proposal.

The Group may propose improvements to the Modification but it is for the Proposer to agree to include any changes in their Proposal.

The Group will present a report to the Modification Panel on how it considers the Modification could be improved and whether or not the Group support the developed Modification proceeding to consultation.

Reports of progress will be provided to meetings of the iGT UNC Modification Panel throughout the period of the Development.

Limits

The Development Group will consider what changes, if any, should be made to the Modification Proposal. The Group will not consider other Modifications or sections of the iGT UNC or other processes.

Composition

Any iGT UNC Operator, Pipeline User, Affected Person, the Authority Representative, the Consumer Representative, the Suppliers Representative or the Large Transporters Representative may attend any meeting of the Development Group.

The Group may invite specialists to attend as necessary

Timetable

The Development should be completed within a period notified by the Panel following determination to submit a matter for Development.

Meetings shall be held at a frequency determined by Development Group.

Meetings will be administered by the iGT UNC Operators and conducted in accordance with the Chairman's Guidelines.
