<p>Facilitation of the relevant objectives</p> <p>We do not believe that this modification better facilitates the relevant objectives as the modification is seeking to re-introduce a section of the former IPL and QPL network codes into short-form codes.</p> <p>Since the iGTs have recognised the need to move to an iGT UNC which provides efficiency in administration, it seems incongruous to expand the individual short form codes for what is in essence a standard industry process, and it would be more efficient to remedy the error in the current process rather than supplant a section of the iGT UNC with a separate section in the short-form code.</p>	
<p>Additional Information and Comments</p> <p>We recognise the importance of the provision of the information that this modification seeks to bring about. However, since the operation of change of supplier processes with IPL/QPL are already governed through their short-form code by the mandating of the use of the "Pipeline Operators Computer System" as detailed in Appendix 1 of their network code, it would be more efficient to ensure that the any file formats reflect the mandatory nature of the information requested, and that should any User(s) not be populating the required fields, that IPL/QPL address the matter with the individual User(s) concerned. Should it be found that the file formats need amendment, there are provisions within the code for a change process which allows for full industry consultation.</p>
