

**iGT057S – Creating CSEP NExA Ancillary**

**Workgroup Report to Panel following Issues Raised in DMR Consultation**

**Background**

A concern highlighted in the Final Modification Report (FMR) for iGT057 – Creating CSEP NExA Ancillary was considered by the iGT UNC Modification Panel on 16<sup>th</sup> April 2014. The issue raised highlighted the fact that the proposal as presented would allow the Ancillary Document governance procedures to be used for updating the Current CSEP NExA Table, which, it was argued, did not constitute a sufficiently robust change mechanism.

The Panel requested that the Final Modification Report be sent to the following iGT Shipper Standing Work Group (19<sup>th</sup> May 2014) and a workgroup report provided to the Panel on 18<sup>th</sup> June 2014, as provided for under the iGT UNC Modification rules.

The workgroup generally agreed that an unintended consequence of the Modification had been to introduce the potential for the current table to be updated via the governance rules for Ancillary Documents. The workgroup also agreed that these rules were not sufficiently robust for a proposed change to the table. The Workgroup agreed by consensus that an additional line should be added to the Modification to state that any future changes to the Ancillary Document introduced by iGT057S must follow the standard Modification Rules instead of the Ancillary Document rules. The consensus in the group was that this was not a material change to the Proposal and would not affect the Self-Governance aspect of the modification.

The Proposer agreed to prepare an amended version of the Modification ahead of the Modification Panel meeting in June 2014.

Separately, a further party agreed to draft a Modification Proposal to remove the separate Code governance rules for Ancillary Documents which the workgroup believed to be outdated and unnecessary now that the IGT UNC Code had a Self-Governance capability within the full Modification Rules.
