ESPUG agrees with the Proposer's view that this modification will have a positive impact on Objective F. The addition of AltHanCo to the Data Permissions Matrix (DPM) is less onerous than creating bespoke permissions in the main body of the UNC and IGT UNC.

As noted by the Proposer, the addition of AltHanCo to the DPM is required to allow the AltHanCo to access the dataset it requires to support an efficient smart meter roll out. This will be dependent on appropriate solution development, a PIA and assessment by the DSC via the CoMc and ChMC where required.
