<b>TPD V16</b>	Parties subject to new Performance Assurance Objective & Principles
Governance – OFGEM	Provision of authorities to the PAC (with protections)
(via UNC Mod process)	Defines new UNC terms for PAC constitution (per 'GT D4' for DSC)

<u>GT B4</u>	PAC carve-out from 4.3.1 and 4.4.2
Governance – OFGEM (via UNC Mod process)	<ul> <li>PAC cannot 'cease to be established' by UNCC vote alone.</li> <li>Parties are obliged to provide information requested by PAC for PA purposes</li> </ul>
<b>PAF Document</b> Governance – PAC	<ul> <li>Performance Assurance Framework Document incorporating:</li> <li>PAFA scope, schedule of services, appointment, risk approach</li> <li>PATs (Performance Assurance Techniques), PARR, procurement</li> <li>Annual PAF Budget, Review, Plan and Consultation</li> </ul>





## Summary of UNC674

Main developments:

- (i) Introduce the Performance Assurance Objective of timely, accurate & equitable Settlement
- (ii) Introduce obligation that Parties' acts & omissions must contribute to achievement of PAO
- (iii) PAC to be constituted as an autonomous UNC sub-Committee (similar to DSC under GT D4)
- (iv) Allow PAC to raise a modification for performance-related proposals
- (v) Move PARR and Risk Register from V12 to PAC-governed PAFD
- (vi) Clarify that CDSP falls under PAC jurisdiction for performance failure (DSC 3.5)
- (vii) Carve-out from GTB 4.4.2 obliging Parties to provide infor requested by PAC for PA purposes
- (viii) Indemnify individuals from PAC, PAFA, CDSP against litigation for legitimate workings of PAC
- (ix) Parties to name a Performance Assurance Party single point of contact
- (x) PAFD contains the PA techniques (inc. peer comparison, referral to OFGEM & appeals)
- (xi) PAC can determine on any act or omission that impacts achievement of the PAO (whether UNC prescribes, proscribes or is silent) and request performance improvements accordingly
- (xii) PAC can set up a sub-Committee if it deems necessary
