

Summary of IGT UNC Workgroups – 13th August 2020

Purpose:

This paper provides Panel members with a summary of IGT UNC Workgroup discussions where applicable each month.

Please note that any Modifications that are on the Panel Agenda and / or subject to a Panel determination are not included in this document.

[IGT132 - Introduction of IGT Code Credit Rules](#)

The Proposer reintroduced the Modification to the Workgroup, focusing on why the Modification was raised, its progress and the Proposer's approach in terms of the modification's solution. The Proposer provided an explanation for basing the legal text on the credit rules within the Distribution Connection and Use of System Agreement (DCUSA) rather than the UNC.

Next steps: The Workgroup are to review the legal text in the September Workgroup Meeting and aim to complete the Workgroup report in October 2020.

[IGT138 - Performance Assurance Techniques and Controls](#)

The Workgroup were provided with an update concerning the progression of the equivalent UNC Modification UNC0674 and informed that an amended version of this Modification would soon be published along with the legal text. The next UNC Workgroup meeting is scheduled for 24th August 2020 at which the Workgroup report will be completed before the Modification goes back to the September Panel meeting. The Workgroup were advised to join the Workgroup for the UNC modification to be involved in its development.

Next steps: The Workgroup are to review the amended IGT UNC Modification with the intention to complete the Workgroup Report at the September 2020 Workgroup meeting.

The Proposer presented the amended Modification and the new guidance Ancillary document, highlighting the changes and clarification added to reflect the feedback provided at the last Workgroup discussion. The new guidance Ancillary document will provide much of the administrative detail around the rules, will be reviewed annually and can be amended by the Panel without a modification.

Next steps: The Workgroup are to review the presented legal text and complete the Workgroup report at the September Workgroup meeting.
