

Summary of IGT UNC Workgroup – 24th September 2021

Purpose:

This paper provides Panel members with a summary of IGT UNC Workgroup discussions where applicable each month.

IGT132VV - Introduction of IGT Code Credit rules

There was a lengthy discussion regarding the RFI questions for both shippers and IGTs. The main issues were the RFI being too long, the questions not specified enough and the lack of credit knowledge in order to design the questions. It was agreed that if the questions are too long and not specific that there may be a low response rate, particularly from shippers. The Workgroup spent a significant amount of time discussing the questions and what sort of answers they need to be looking for. It was agreed that they should not steer too far away from Ofgem's questions and a list of ideas were agreed.

CA is to redraft the RFI and to present it to the October 2021 Workgroup for a last assessment before sending out to industry and the responses are to be reviewed in the November 2021 Workgroup.
