IGT172: Provision for Gas Entry within the IGT UNC

Please briefly summarise the key reason(s) for your support / opposition

SGN supports this modification proposal as its implementation will facilitate the flow of new sources of gas being entered onto the total system from an Independent Gas Transporter (iGT) pipeline via a Distribution Network Operator (DNO) network. This modification is required to establish gas entry requirements in the iGT UNC that don't currently exist and to facilitate the transfer of title and risk of the gas between code parties. If this modification is not approved then UNC Modification 0842 Gas Entry onto the Total System via an Independent Gas Transporter cannot be implemented as it is reliant on this modification also being implemented.

It is also worth mentioning that this modification will help to facilitate the expansion of the Green Gas Support Scheme aimed at expanding UK produced gas.

We believe that this modification should be subject to an authority direction as this is the case with UNC modification 0842 that will also be determined by the authority.
