

Summary of IGT UNC Workgroup – 11th June 2026

Purpose:

This paper provides Panel members with a summary of IGT UNC Workgroup discussions each month. IGT UNC Modifications:

[RG008 - IGT UNC Code Review in preparation for Code Manager and Code Consolidation](#)

In line with the phase one activities agreed previously, the Review Group completed a collaborative review of Part L with the aim of highlighting IGT-specific provisions (nuances) that parties had identified in advance of the meeting. There were numerous differences highlighted between the IGT UNC and UNC on processes for Modifications, Reviews and Meetings, and some discussion was held on the difficulties to be faced into consolidating both Codes under one set of Modification Rules, whilst maintaining key IGT UNC nuances. It was agreed that the next meeting of the Review Group would focus on the collaborative review of Part O (Derogations) and the Derogations Guidance Document.

[IGT180 - CDSP Obligations required for the introduction of the Gas Shipper Obligation \(GSO\)](#)

Ben Mitchell (Xoserve) provided an update on IGT180. Due to a delay in the Department of Energy Security and Net Zero (DESNZ) publishing its response to the GSO Obligation, there is now insufficient time to progress IGT180 and [UNC0922](#) through the respective Modification routes as planned, ahead of the GSO go-live date in 2027. Both Modifications will be withdrawn and replaced with two new Modifications focused only on the enduring post-implementation service.

[IGT183 – Maintenance criteria for Emergency Contact data held in Central Systems](#)

Kathryn Adeseye (Xoserve) introduced IGT183, which is an equivalent Modification to [UNC 0926](#), aligning the IGT UNC with the UNC to establish clear rules on how Consumer emergency contact data should be maintained, retained, and handled. The Workgroup went through the Modification Proposal Form and Business Rules, with an aim to review the Modification legal text in July and to complete the Workgroup Report in August.
